Staff ratio: Afterschool: 1:12

Afterschool Club: school pick up 1.05 to 6.30pm. (50 places) Out of term time, we offer full day afterschool for our children.

Age ranges: Afterschool is aimed at children from 4 – 12 years. (Junior Infants up to 6<sup>th</sup> Class)

**Our facilities:** Our creche facility has 2 rooms: We have 2 large bright rooms with lots of ventilation available to our preschool, full time and afterschool children. We also have a lovely garden, which is well equipped with suitable equipment for both preschool and primary school children. We also have a multipurpose room that we can use for drama, ball skills, yoga, rest and quiet time or anything else we dream up as a group to meet the emergent interests of our groups.

## What do we do:

Afterschool: The afterschool caters for children from 4-12 and we drop off and collect from all local primary schools. We currently have 3 staff working in the afterschool and will bring more into the team should we have numbers that require it.

**Schools we cater for:** all national schools in the Greystones area.

We are very conscious that children attending from school can be tired from a busy day of learning and so we make our environment as enjoyable as possible and ensure plenty of rest and relaxation, as well as structured time for each child. We are very conscious of children in afterschool having diverse needs in terms of their wider age group and also their own interests. Therefore we offer a wide range of activities at any one time so that we can suit each child's needs each day. Some of these activities include Baking, Arts and crafts, Board games, Sports, Reading, Fun games both indoors and outdoors, Music .
